## Alamosa Springsnail, *Tryonia alamosae* Family: Hydrobiidae      Group: Snails

<b>Current Status:</b>	<b>Endangered</b> [also State-listed: Endangered]
<b>Status Details</b>	The Alamosa springsnail was first listed on <b>September 30, 1991</b> . It is currently designated as <b>Endangered</b> in the <b>Entire Range</b> . The published range of this species includes: <b>New Mexico</b> . <i>(Please note, the current range of this species may be quite different from the published range)</i>
