Colorado (=squawfish) Pikeminnow

Current Status: Different populations of this species are listed differently.
See Federal Register and Recovery Plan for complete listing details.

Current Status: **Endangered with Critical Habitat** [also State-listed: Endangered]

Status Details The Colorado pikeminnow (=squawfish) was first listed on **March 11, 1967**. It is currently designated as **Endangered** in the **Entire range, except Salt and Verde R. drainages, AZ**. The published range of this species includes: California, Colorado, **New Mexico**, Nevada, Utah, and Wyoming. *(Please note, the current range of this species may be quite different from the published range)*

Experimental Population, Non-Essential

On **July 24, 1985**, the Colorado pikeminnow (=squawfish) was designated as **Experimental Population, Non-Essential** in the Salt and Verde R. drainages, AZ.

Lead Region The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service **Mountain-Prairie Region (Region 6)** is the lead region for this entity
