## Knowlton's Cactus, *Pediocactus knowltonii* Family: Cactaceae      Group: Flowering Plants

<b>Current Status:</b>	<b>Endangered</b> [also State-listed: Endangered; EMNRD 2006]
<b>Status Details</b>	The Knowlton cactus was first listed on <b>October 29, 1979</b> . It is currently designated as <b>Endangered</b> in the <b>Entire Range</b> . The published range of this species includes: <b>Colorado, New Mexico</b> ( <i>Please note, the current range of this species may be quite different from the published range</i> )
