Status Details	The Pecos assimineea snail was first listed on August 09, 2005 . It is currently designated as Endangered in the Entire Range . The published range of this species includes: New Mexico, Texas, and Mexico . <i>(Please note, the current range of this species may be quite different from the published range)</i>
