## Razorback Sucker, *Xyrauchen texanus*

Family: Catostomidae

Group: Fishes

<b>Current Status:</b>	<b>Endangered with Critical Habitat</b> [also State-listed as Sensitive]
<b>Status Details</b>	The Razorback sucker was first listed on <b>October 23, 1991</b> . It is currently designated as <b>Endangered</b> in the <b>Entire Range</b> . The published range of this species includes: Arizona, California, Colorado, <b>New Mexico</b> , Nevada, Utah, Wyoming; and Mexico <i>(Please note, the current range of this species may be quite different from the published range)</i>
<b>Lead Region</b>	The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service <b>Mountain-Prairie Region (Region 6)</b> is the lead region for this entity
<b>Critical Habitat</b>	YES
