Southwestern Willow Flycatcher, *Empidonax traillii extimus* Family: Tyrannidae Group: Birds

Current Status: **Endangered with Critical Habitat** [also State-listed: Endangered]

Status Details The Southwestern willow flycatcher was first listed on **February 27, 1995**. It is currently designated as **Endangered** in the **Entire Range**. The published range of this species includes: Arizona, California, Colorado, **New Mexico**, Texas, Utah; and Central America.
(Please note, the current range of this species may be quite different from the published range).

Lead Region The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service **Southwest Region (Region 2)** is the lead region for this entity.

Critical Habitat YES. Critical Habitat was initially designated for this entity, later vacated, then formally designated again on October 19, 2005.
